About Our Program

One expert recently suggested that the majority of PA dairy farms fall within the Chesapeake Bay Watershed. And even those that lie outside the watershed may ultimately be touched by these regulations. The Chesapeake is already seen as a model project for other watersheds across the nation, so regulations being implemented here are likely to follow in other areas.

This PDMP Dairy Industry Issue Forum was scheduled specifically to coincide as closely as possible with the release of the new watershed rules.

The speakers are people who have been at the heart of the development of the new plan or are those who will be charged with its implementation. This is another PDMP meeting where you get information directly from those who are in the know.

Farms in Lancaster, Franklin and Dauphin counties are already seeing the impact of closer scrutiny. While many large farms have been ahead of the curve on this environmental issue, it is small to medium farms that are at risk if the managers don't understand and follow the rules.

In addition to hearing the ins and outs of the watershed plan, this session will put farmers in touch with people who can help them identify the problems on their farms and guide them to solutions. Attendees will also be positioned to open beneficial dialogue with the regulators and groups who are monitoring implementation of the regulations.

Our program will close with a visit to Spring Lawn Farm, where the owners are using technology to not only meet the challenges of the new regulations but also to increase their profitability. At each stop on the farm, experts will be talking about how decisions were made, how the farm will benefit, and how similar changes can be affected at other dairy farms.
